



5th Grade Incentives and Pledge information

Your student can earn rewards in 2 ways as we reach our Boosterthon fundraising goal together!

1. St. Luke School has established a plan for students to earn rewards as a grade. Based on the average amount of money Pledged Per Lap (PPL) by the grade, ALL students in the grade can earn the following:

- \$10 PPL per grade- chew gum/eat candy in class
- \$20 PPL per grade – homework pass
- \$40 PPL per grade – 5 bonus points on a test
- \$80 PPL per grade – Indoor recess
- \$120 PPL per grade – afternoon movie
- \$160 PPL per grade - movie in the Ministry Center with popcorn
- \$200 PPL per grade – ice cream treat at recess
- \$260 PPL per grade – week no homework (excluding tests)
- \$320 PPL per grade – out of uniform week

2. Students can also earn individual rewards as follows from the Boosterthon organization based on individual pledges per lap as follows:

- \$1/lap - Invisible Ink Pen
- \$2/lap - Bungee Rocket
- \$3/lap - Booster ball kit
- \$5/lap - KidFit water bottle
- \$7/lap - Light-up shoe laces
- \$10/lap - Ring Sticks (game for 2)
- \$15/lap - Herosteps watch
- \$20/lap - Bubble chopper
- \$30/lap - Riff Racer (remote control)
- \$50/lap - Drift Trike

For example, if 5th grade students as a grade reach \$320 per lap, ALL students in 5th grade will earn ALL the grade level rewards from the \$10 level through the \$320 level.

Additionally, if your student, as an individual, gets a \$1 pledge per lap from her grandmother, \$3 pledge per lap from her aunt, and a \$6 pledge per lap from the parent, your student will receive all prizes from the \$1 level through the \$10 level throughout the week as the pledges are made.
